CCP is no longer a required course but if a student chooses to take the course at SCHS during the day BOTH CCP and Health will need to be taken. It is advised to take Health over the online/summer.

Additional Notes

- ▶ A core Music class during the school day, Band or Orchestra, is required to participate in Marching Band if you play a Wind or Percussion instrument
- ▶ Members of the Triton Marching Alliance and Jazz Band need to take a core music class during the school day.
- ▶ Students must also pass the California HS Exit Exam and take the required CCP (College and Career Planning)/Health class during High School.
- ▶ *Health may be taken over the summer (online) if students have impacted schedules due to programs: Music, IB, AP, or AVID. Only 1 class may be taken each summer.
